300 WATERUSERS INVOLVED

HEARING OF WATER RIGHTS IN UMATILLA COUNTY ON.

Water Superintendent Cochran Oversees the Service.

Sheriff T. D. Taylor and Deputy Joe Blakeley yesterday began service upon 300 claimants to right to the waters of the Umatilla river and its tributaries, at Pendleton, citing them to appear before the board of control in Pendleton on June 12 to answer the contest to their claims. George T. Cochran, water commissioner for division 2, was in Pendleton yesterday in connection with the contests which are being prosecuted for the government by Oliver P. Morton, assistant United States attorney.

About a year ago, the government authorities, desiring to have the right to these waters adjudicated, had meetings called at Echo and Pendleton, at which all claimants to water, either for irrigation, power or watering purposes, were asked to file the amount to which they laid claim. About three months later, other meetings were called for inspection purposes at which any person had the right to inspect the claim of any other. Following these inspections, contests were made in about three hundred cases and these are the cases which are to be decided next June before the members of the state board, consisting of the state engineer and the two water commissioners, sitting as a court. Should the decisions of this board be objected to, the cases can be appealed to the circuit court.

The majority of the complaints allege that the claimants have laid claim to more water than they are entitled to and the board is asked to disallow all claims that are against fact, without right, wrongful, improper or excessive and that the water rights be determined subject in any event to such prior rights as contestant has.

scribed improvement be made; that the boundaries of said district to be so improved are as follows:

(A) And the property affected or benefitted by said improvement is as follows:

Commencing at the junction of Willow street and the O.-W. R. & N. Co.'s railway track, thence northwest to block "A", Honan's addition, thence southwest 250 feet, thence west down center of Jefferson avenue to the center of Fourth street and Jefferson avenue, thence north on Fourth street to center of Division street, thence west on Division street to city limits, thence south to center of Baker street, thence east on Baker street and "Z" avenue to a point directly north of the center line (north and south) of block 15, Gangloff's addition, thence south to center of "N" avenue, thence east on "N" avenue to a point directly south of the center line (north and south) of block 2, Wisdom's addition to La Grande, thence north in alley between Cedar street and Oak street to center of "O" avenue, thence east on "O" avenue to Cedar street, thence north on Cedar street to Pennsylvania avenue, thence east on Pennsylvania avenue to a point opposite the center line (north and south) of block 11, Grandy's addition to the city of La Grande, thence north in alley between Second street and Third street to Main avenue, thence east on Main avenue to a point south of center (north and south) of block 1, Grandy's addition to the city of La Grande, thence north in alley between

Third and Fourth streets to Adams avenue, thence southeast down Adams avenue to Willow street, thence east on Willow street to the place of beginning.

Notice is hereby further given that the council will levy a special assessment on all the property affected and benefitted by such improvement for the purpose of paying for such improvement. That the estimated cost of such improvement is the sum of \$71,800.08. That the council will on the 26th day of April, 1911, meet at the council chamber at the hour of 8 o'clock p. m., to consider said estimated cost, and the levy of said assessment, when a hearing will be granted to any person feeling aggrieved by such assessment.
