Farmer Union Menu at Joseph Will Be Novel Affair.

It will be a joint meeting of the unions of the four principal counties of Eastern Oregon and arrangements for the affair are now being made. The suggestion that Umatilla county furnish the strawberries and each of the other counties an appropriate part of the "feed" originated with W. W. Harrah, of Pendleton. Other members of the union quickly took up with the idea and it was adopted.

Opening Yakima Division.
