## PASSION PLAY IS SEEN TODAY

INVITED AUDIENCE SEES THE PICTURES THIS MORNING.

First Production Proper Came This Afternoon at Matinee.

Oberammergau was brought manifestly nearer to La Grande and the historical series of events—the birth, youth, suffering and death of Jesus Christ—taken out of the past and paraded in the present when the Arcade theatre introduced the Passion Play films today. The first run was made to a gathering of clergy, private citizens and newspaper men this forenoon but the first audience proper to see the production was this afternoon when the matinee went on. The picture, run in three films, will be put on again this evening, tomorrow afternoon and tomorrow night, for the last time. The price remains the same as before.

That beautiful story of the journey of the three Wise Men, the vision of the shepherds, the flight to Egypt, the life story of Jesus, his subsequent sufferings, his trial and crucifixion are all told from the Oberammergau production and as the pictures are clear and distinct, the audience will gain a fine notion of what the Passion Play, presented every ten years by the peasants of Oberammergau, really is when seen first hand. To the man and woman and boy and girl who cannot see the original, the film is a fine substitute.
