igan, shouted it out the other day. The end is not yet.

Another rifle shooting trophy has recently been added to the collection

at the office of the secretary of war.

The latest addition to the prizes is the Dewar cup, which has just arrived from England. This cup was won by the American team last year, in competition with teams of Great Britain and Australia. Each country was represented by a men shooting small cal-

ber rifles at 75 feet.

The trophy is a silver cup, 30 inches high, which cost \$500. It was presented by Sir Thomas Dewar of England. It will remain in the custody of the United States one year, when it will again be put in competition.

The national capital will soon be the

scene of a continuous aviation tournament. Furthermore, there will be no ticket takers on the field, and visitors may acquire the "aviation neck" without charge. Uncle Sam is the showman.

Negotiations are about completed for the lease of grounds near Washington by the war department for use as an aerodrome. The department already is arranging to buy several aeroplanes, an appropriation of \$125,000 having been made for the purpose by both houses of congress. The senate has voted that \$25,000 of this sum be made immediately available.

Brigadier General Allen has asked aeroplane makers to make offers, and expects soon to have one or more machines in Washington.

The erection of hangers for the accommodation of the machines, will be begun shortly.

It is planned to begin flying in Washington as soon as the weather moderates, and is less unsettled. Lieutenant Benjamin D. Foulois of the signal corps, now on aeroplane duty along the Mexican border, will be called to take charge of the instruction of other officers. Two army officers are with Glenn Curtiss near San Diego learning to fly, and they will undoubtedly be called to Washington for aero work.

Daily flights will be made, and numerous tests and experiments are being planned. The army has taken up the work of developing an aeroplane corps in earnest, and from now on serious work is contemplated.

Washington Briefs.

The navy department is planning for next month a series of tests with a gyroscope, to determine its value in maintaining the stability of a warship in rough seas. The torpedo boat destroyer Worden is to be used in the tests, which will be held off the Virginia capes.

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
