NEW PRESIDENT AND DIRECTOR ELECTED

CHAUTAQUA DIRECTORS HOLD IMPORTANT MEETING.

Dr. McMillan Succeeds T. A. Rinehart—Logan New Director.

Election of a president to succeed T. A. Rinehart, resigned, election of a vice president and a director to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of Mr. Rinehart, when he became state land agent, plans for resuming the Chautauqua ticket sales, and various other matters came before the hold-over directors at the first meeting in some time last night. Chautauqua matter were discussed at length and the election of officers paves the way for concerted action to make the second annual event a far more unqualified success than the first. Dr. W. D. McMillan, a charter director of the association, was elected president. John Collier, of the Peoples store, is vice president, and R. W. Logan is the new director.

The directors will hold regular weekly meetings hereafter, Thursday evenings being set aside for that purpose.

The advance ticket sale which was commenced a time since but dropped for the time being, will again be resumed. The program is rapidly assuming perfection and will shortly be ready for announcement in detail. The main numbers, of course, are already provided for.

The directors displayed plenty of enthusiasm last evening and the big July event will be handled with every possible attention to the minutest detail, the object being to give the ticket holders just as much as is possible.

MANY SUPREME COURT CASES

UNION AND WALLOWA COUNTIES SEND UP IMPORTANT ONES.

Meeting of Supreme Court in Pendleton Monday of Great Interest.

A sitting of the May term of the Pendleton branch of the state supreme court commencing next Monday will be of more widespread interest, locally perhaps, than any session of late years. The cases to be argued before that august body number many and all are very important.

The appealed case of L. Remillard of this city accused of illicit selling of liquor when this county was dry, will come up for argument; the same is true of the Townsend whiskey cases from Palmer Junction. Another matter of great importance to Wallowa county and in this connection, is the appealed decision of Judge Knowles relative to the rights and privileges of wet towns in dry counties. The application of the Home Rule law is involved and not only Wallowa county but the entire state is much interested.

Then, too, the Coolidge vs. O. R. & N. case, a bit of litigation of much interest locally, will be up for argument.

The famous escheat case, in which the state of Oregon has twice secured a circuit court jury verdict, but which the supreme court sent back for retrial after the first verdict for the state, will again appear, having been appealed from a decision of the circuit court. This case involves the Morrison estate in this county and also figured indirectly in the late session of the legislature.
