A New Sanitary Scheme For Schools. Dr. C. E. Coulter, president of the board of education of Ogden, Utah, stated that in accordance with the board's determination to give the "sanitary towel" a tryout in the local schools orders have been placed with the manufacturers for a trial consignment, which will be installed at once. 
