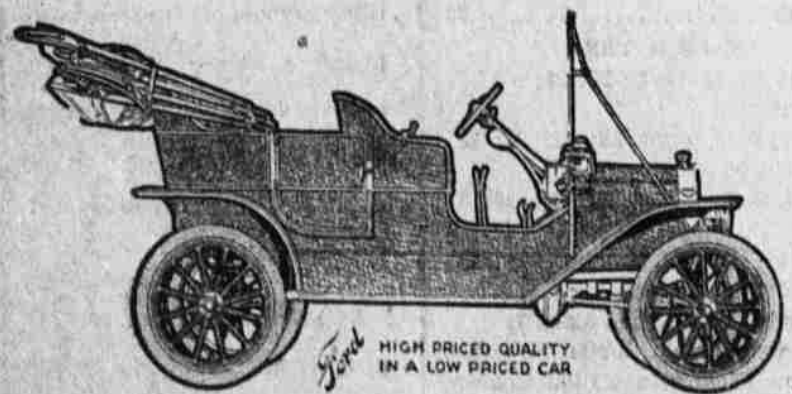

LETTER COMES FROM SAMOA

LOCAL MISSIONARY TELLS OF HIS TRIP TO ISLANDS.

La Grande L. D. S. Missionary Pleas- ed With His Surroundings.

Writing from Pasoga, Upolu, in Samoa, Joseph Spiker of this city tells of his first experiences in the Samoan islands as a missionary for the L. D. S. church. Mr. Spiker left last winter and his first impressions of the island, and of his trip, are briefly told in a letter received yesterday evening by O. E. Silverthorne. Relating his experiences, Mr. Spiker writes:

"I left Vancouver, B. C., on January 22, 1911, and sailed for Suva, Fiji. We had seven hours at Honolulu. I enjoyed it while there although I got seasick again on going aboard. All together we were on the ocean about 16 days and then landed at Sinva. About eight days out of the 16 I was seasick and awful sick, too. Landing at Sinva I found it very tiresome to pass away the 24 days which I had to wait to catch a boat for Apia. It took three days sailing from Sinva to Apia, and I was sick all the days. Upon my arrival I found a warm reception waiting for me and was very glad to get on land once again. I landed here on Sunday morning and that afternoon I gave my opening address to a native assembly in the church house. I am now 20 miles from Apia, at the plantation and right in the midst of the island. My native name here is Mr. Fika, and they seem awful glad that I have come. I have been to Sunday school this morning and enjoyed it. There were about 150 people present and they sang the songs that I used to hear at home, although Samoan, better than I ever heard them sung before. They are all natural born singers and musicians. They are fast becoming civilized and for personal cleanliness they can not be excelled. The Samoans are very fair complexioned people and some of them are almost white.

"Well, as soon as I catch on to the language a little bit more I will go to teaching school and also teaching a music class by night. In conclusion I wish to say that this is the most beautiful place I believe that you will find in the world. Give my best regards to all."
