**NEW INSURANCE COMPANY**

**FARMERS UNION PERFECT ORGANIZATION AT PENDLETON.**

J. W. McAllister of La Grande Vice President of the Company.

Final details of the consolidation of the Farmers' Union Insurance company with the Pacific States Fire Insurance company, announced exclusively in this paper yesterday, were completed today, says the Pendleton Live Wire.

As published, the union was effected with the powerful million dollar corporation assuming all liabilities, contracts and policies of the Umatilla county home company, and was brought about solely as a result of the desire of the Farmers' Union company stockholders to make on great Oregon insurance enterprise possible.

As it is now, the consolidation means the creation of an Oregon fire insurance company equal to the largest in the United States. Manuel Friedly, of Helix, president; J. W. McAllister, president of the State Farmers' union and vice-president of the Farmers' Union company; C. C. Conors, secretary; Dr. J. U. Temple, treasurer; Judge J. W. Maloney and D. H. Nelson, directors, represented the interests of the Umatilla company at yesterday's meeting.

The Pacific States company was represented by President F. E. Best of Portland and C. L. Ayres, J. Stevens and C. W. Alger.

An office will be maintained in Pendleton and Messers Ayres, Stevens and Alger, who have been here for a number of years, will remain for another week. E. W. McComas is to be the local representative of the consolidated company.

Ex-President Friedly of the Farmers' Union company, will have a place on the directorate of the Pacific States concern, thus giving Umatilla a count an active voice in the affairs of the consolidated concern.

**Retiring Board's Statement.**

For the old board of directors, Dr Temple made the following statement today:

"In retiring from the field of fire insurance the Farmers' Union directors bespeak their heartiest co-operation for the Pacific States company. We investigated the matter thoroughly and came to the conclusion that the unity of interests would be feasible, practical and generally desirable, working to the best interests of all directly or indirectly concerned.

"We ask from our patrons the same loyal consideration and support for the consolidated company that has been shown to us in the past, believing fully in the future welfare of the consolidated institution."
