One of the interesting features of the meeting will be the celebration next Sunday of the 100th anniversary of the birth of Dr. Walther, the founder of the synod.

Washington, May 10.—Through an error the report has been circulated that the battleship Wyoming was to be launched at Philadelphia tomorrow. The navy department desires it to be known that the launching will take place May 25, when the vessel will be christened by Miss Dorothy Eunice Knight daughter of a former chief justice of Wyoming. The Wyoming is a first class battleship, with 26,000 tons displacement.
