DODENDORF "SKINS' UNCLE SAM.

Letter From Brother at Grand Island Tacked to New Engine and Is Picked Up Like Wireless Message at Destination in La Grande.

Strange freaks of transmission of thought are seemingly seen in an incident occurring at the railroad yards yesterday morning. A note written on a rough piece of paper and pinned to an engine in the Grand Island yards was found by the person to whom it was addressed in La Grande and that by the merest chance.

Harry Dodendorf, a conductor of this city, has a brother who is a dispatcher in Grand Island. On the 23rd of April he was in the yards and saw a new engine just out of the Baldwin works that was "boxed up" for shipment to the coast, and knowing that it would eventually pass through La Grande as a freight load, he picked

up a piece of paper, wrote on it "Hello, Harry Dodendorf at La Grande, Ore. (Signed W. E. Dodendorf)." In the course of time the engine reached the La Grande yards on its trip west, and yesterday morning Harry was in the yards and noticed the new engine going through. A casual inspection disclosed to him a piece of card board pinned to the engine where it could be readily seen, and on closer inspection found the message from his brother sent so many hundred miles by freight. C. M. Humphrey, who is well acquainted with the Grand Island dispatcher, corroborates Mr. Dodendorf in identifying the handwriting. Harry knew nothing whatever of the incident before finding the paper tacked to the engine.
