RUNAWAY FATAL TO ONE

ONE DEAD AND OTHERS HURT
NEAR PENDLETON.

Trip to Ball Game Results Fatally to One, Injurious to Four.

(Pendleton East Oregonian.)
One man dead and four others seriously injured is the result of a tragic accident which happened on the road between Athena and Weston last night about 8:30. Charles Wilson, a well-known allottee on the reservation, was killed. William Duffy had his pelvic bone broken. Percy Wilson was injured internally. Frank Pambrum had an arm broken and Roy Walker received a number of bad cuts and bruises when their team ran away, collided with a telephone pole and hurled all the occupants of the truck out.

The five men were returning home after witnessing the Pendleton-Athena ball game at Athena yesterday. In some manner the team, which was being driven by Charles Wilson, became frightened, and was soon beyond control. The occupants were all thrown from the rig when it struck against a telephone pole, the driver being hurled against the pole with such force that his skull was crushed and his neck broken, but the others escaped with only the injuries mentioned above.

Dr. Plamondon of Athena was immediately summoned but death had been instantaneous with Mr. Wilson. Coroner Folsom of this city was notified and at once dispatched Judge Joe H. Parkes to make an investigation, who decided that an inquest was unnecessary.

The deceased man who was about 26 years of age. Lived three miles south of Athena and leaves a wife and two children to mourn his tragic end. Mrs. Wilson was in Walla Walla attending a theatre at the time of the accident and was immediately notified.

Duffy is a resident of Walla Walla but has holdings in this county. He had been spending the day visiting with Mr. Wilson.

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution adopted by the common council of the city of La Grande, Oregon, on the 18th day of August, 1909, creating improvement district No. 7 and designating Monroe avenue as such district and in pursuance of a resolution adopted by said common council on the 12th day of April, 1911, whereby said council determined and declared its intention to improve all that portion of Monroe avenue in said improvement district as hereinafter described, by building cement walks 5 feet wide, the council will, ten days after the service of this notice upon the owners of the property affected and benefitted by such improvement, order that said above described improvement be made; that the boundaries of said district to be so improved are as follows:

All that portion of Monroe avenue, from the east line of North Fir street, to the west line of North Spruce street.

(A) And the property affected or benefitted by said improvement is as follows: All the north half of blocks 122, 123 and 124 and the south half of block 147 and 149, all in Chaplin's addition to the city of La Grande, Oregon.

Notice is hereby further given that the council will levy a special assessment on all the property affected and benefitted by such improvement for the purpose of paying for such improvement. That the estimated cost of such improvement is the sum of 2,128.35. That the council will on the 17th day of May, 1911, meet at the council chamber at the hour of 8 o'clock p. m., to consider said estimated cost, and the levy of said assessment, when a hearing will be granted to any person feeling aggrieved by such assessment.

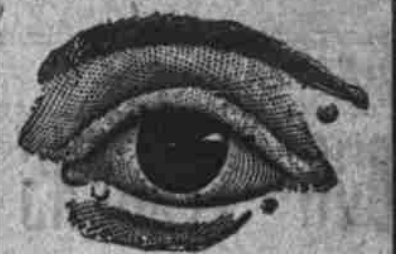
