WHEAT LAND IS PROFITABLE

IOWA FARMER BUYS TRACT FOR ORCHARD PURPOSES.

Will Plant 140 Acres, Paying \$150.00 an Acre for It

Eighteen thousand, two hundred dollars have been paid for 130 acres of Allcel wheat land and that piece of land will be planted at once to orchard. The buyer is Asa Taylor a Red Oak, Iowa, farmer who has disposed of his holdings in that state and has cast his lot with the Grande Ronde valley. Mr Taylor will move his family to Allcel where he will build a comfortable home and make his headquarters while supervising the planting and culture of his 140 acre orchard.

The land was purchased from P. A. McDonald by Frank R. Bridges, and Mr. Bridges is the seller to Mr Taylor. The deal is but another reflection of the increasing value of farm land in the Allcel and Imbler districts. Less years ago than can be counted on the fingers of one hand similar property sold for approximately half of what Mr. Taylor paid for it and in another five years, all things being equal, it will have doubled and even tripled over its present value.

Another Deal Closed.

C. R. Buell of Seattle has purchased 20 acres of orchard in the Mt. Emily district from the Cleaver-Bridges firm and for a while at least will leave in La Grande but may eventually move to his tract.

L. J. Price has purchased 15 acres of orchard land at Imbler, paying \$500 an acre.
