COVE FRUITMEN ORGANIZE

ORGANIZATION AN ESTABLISHED FACT THERE.

More Transfers in Real Estate and More Planting of Orchards.

(By a Cove Booster.)

The Cove Fruit association, mentioned in an Observer article recently, is now an established fact, having effected permanent organization and applied for their incorporation papers, sufficient stock being subscribed for at one single meeting, and a board of directors and officers elected for one year, as follows: M. J. Duffey, president; H. Liurence, vice president; Karl J. Stackland, secretary and the Cove State Bank, treasurer.

With a set of by-laws adopted that will guarantee absolute fairness, both as to basis for voting in disposing of the fruit, but also, as to all other important matters, and stipulating free and unlimited inspection of all accounts and correspondence to any been determined to affiliate with the member or patron. It also, having Northwestern Fruit exchange for this year with all the carlot shipments and to engage an outside expert during the apple packing and grading season so as to gain a satisfactory uniformity with other localities, as well as to satisfy all of getting a square deal.

Among the recent Cove transfers here are:

J. W. Baxter sold the 40 acre tract to the three Stackland brothers.

J. S. Houx to E. W. Pease, a 40 acre fruit farm, two miles east of Cove, consideration \$5,000.

J. W. Baxter and Geo. Baxter to B. F. Bell 10 acres one mile east of town, consideration \$2,000.

Reed and Stackland of Portland, Ore., to Karl J. Stackland, 14 acres, adjoining the buyer's home place just east of town, consideration \$2,000.

A. G. Conklin will also join in the pear planting procession by planting about 500 Beurre d'Anjou trees this week.

Also, our "old timer" Mr. Dunham Wright, is making preparations to start a good sized orchard this spring and will plant about 500 Anjous and 1,000 apple trees.

Mr. Zimmerle of the Grande Ronde Orchard company on the tract near Cove, had planted 100 acres in apples this spring, instead of 80 acres, as reported.
