## NEW TRAIN ON THE O-W

EAST TRAIN SERVICE TO BE IMPROVED AT ONCE.

May Take Off One of the Slow Trains, or Add a New One.

A new and fast train is promised the O-W soon according to an announcement made in a Portland paper which says:

Inauguration of a second fast train service between Portland and Chicago is contemplated by officials of the Harriman lines and likely will be put into effect within 30 days.

Gerrit Fort, passenger traffic manager of the Union Pacific and Oregon Short Line railroads, was in Portland yesterday and said that such additional service as will give Portland two three-day trains with Chicago, instead of one, as at present, is under consideration. The details of the schedule and the time when the service will be established have not been worked out, he added.

This improvement is in accordance with the policy of Harriman officials to reduce the running time between Pacific coast cities and the east. Arrangements for faster service and better conditions between San Francisco and New York have been announced, but this service will not benefit Portland direct. The San Francisco service will be brought about through increased speed on the Overland Limited, the Union Pacific's fast transcontinental train. As none of the O-W. R. & N. trains connect with the Overland Limited the local service will not be affected.

In giving Portland the second three-day schedule the Harriman lines will place in commission a complete through train between Chicago and the northwest. It has not been decided, however, whether this will be an entirely new train or whether it will take the place of one of the already in service.

### Service Due in June.

Mr. Fort declared that he is ready to announce the Chicago-Portland arrangement, but admitted that it may be a reality early in June. He intends to seek a connection here with the O-W. R. & N. company's Portland service to give Seattle the lift.

"Every prospect is bright for heavy tourist business to the northwest this year," said Mr. Fort, "don't see why people don't come in greater numbers. I came along the Columbia river this spring and I never saw more delightful scenery. The only thing in the try that can compare with it Hudson river, and I think the Columbia has the advantage over the Hudson because it is more rugged and more picturesque."

Northwest Is Advertised. "We are spending considerable money in advertising the northwest throughout the east. That should attract many visitors. Much of the heavy appropriation recently voted by the Harriman lines for advertising purposes will be used in exploiting the northwest."

Mr. Fort brought with him a number of proofs of ads that have been inserted recently in leading papers and magazines throughout the east in which the merits of his portion of the country is extolled. These will be framed to be presented to the Portland Commercial club.

"We are spending other vast sums in improvements," he continued, "including double-tracking, installation of safety devices and block signals, ballasting and the purchase of equipment. Now we are going to give the public the benefit of some of these betterments in improved service."

Mr. Fort is a prominent member of the Omaha lodge of Elks and is an enthusiastic supporter of Portland for the 1912 convention. Through his efforts many "Portland 1912" clubs have been organized among the lodges in the middle west and all these will unite in the endeavor to bring the big meeting to this city next year.
