Fourth and Sixth were presented and ordered paid.

After a considerable tussle the park commission won, through its friends last evening, when an ordinance was passed selling to Contractor Darley the original park site lots on West Adams avenue. Several years ago the ladies of La Grande purchased these lots for park site purposes by the hardest kind of work, and then two years ago deeded them to the city. In the meantime the ladies fulfilled their motives in perfecting Riverside park and Contractor Darley did a lot of work out there, and was to be paid in part by the sale of the original park lots. This ordinance was finally passed, three voting against it, last evening and the Park association will therefore realize some benefit from the work done several years ago.

An ordinance changing the sign ordinance to permit the electric signs being swung across the sidewalks was introduced. Regulation of attachment to sewer mains was cared for in an ordinance last night.
