UTAH FINANCIER IMPRESSED

TELLS SALT LAKE PAPER OF GROWING UNION COUNTY.

Wealthy Utah Resident Much Pleased 'With Grande Ronde Valley.

La Grande, the Grande Ronde valley and the various towns in it come in for much publicity through the Deseret News of Salt Lake, following the publication of a statement of Frank J. Hewlett of Salt Lake in La Grande some time ago. Mr. Hewlett was a guest of A. S. Geddes while here and gave considerable attention to publicity data. The Deseret News, quoting Mr. Hewlett, who is one of the wealthiest men in Utah, remarks:

"Frank J. Hewlett, president of the Hewlett Bros. company of this city, is enthusiastic in his praise of the Grande Ronde valley, in Eastern Oregon. He recently spent several days in the Oregon country on a business trip. Speaking of the Grande Ronde valley, Mr. Hewlett said:

"As you enter the Grande Ronde valley you see the pretty and prosperous town of Union, nestling near the verdure covered hills.

"Union is one of the most attractive of Grande Ronde valley towns. It has considerable commercial importance. A large woolen mill, flour mill, four planing mills, saw mills soon to be built, residence section like a vast orchard, ample water for irrigation, two banks, two weekly newspapers and a wide-awake commercial club.

"We next come to La Grande, situated in the heart of the beautiful Grande Ronde valley. La Grande has a payroll of \$135,000 per month; a saw mill worth \$500,000; a sugar factory valued at \$250,000; also a large foundry and machine shops. La Grande has fine churches and schools, electric lights, water works, sewerage system and is an ideal home and business city. There are now 1,600 acres bearing orchards, winter apples, and near-

ly that many more has been planted last spring in the Grande Ronde valley.

La Grande is proud of her progressive Commercial club, organized as follows: Bruce Dennis, president; W. J. Church, secretary; Mac Woods, W. Holmes, George Currey, Joseph Carr, John Collier, Charles Dunn and A. S. Geddes, a former Salt Laker, constitute the board of directors. S. M. Slough, a real live wire, is publicity manager. A league of commercial clubs is now being formed in Union and Wallowa counties, Elgin, Union, Cove, Hot Lake, Summerville, Imbler, Wallowa, Enterprise, Joseph and La Grande are the links to form a strong commercial chain. An earnest appeal will be sent forth, ringing with strong arguments for more factories and industries, and the fine lands of which there are plenty to be filled up with thousands of good farmers.

"The famous Grande Ronde valley embraces 600 square miles. It seems level to the eye, but the silver threads of waterways betray the gradual slope to a major river course.

"The tillers of the soil are jubilant over the late rains. It has been a wonderful aid for spring wheat, which has now been given ample chance to mature, and it has been estimated in Oregon and Washington, the renewal of the spring sowing by the late rains has added at least 15,000,000 bushels of grain to the total output of what was expected 15 days ago. Abundant crops of fruits, cereals and vegetables are assured."

LEG IS AMPUTATED.

Arthur Oliver Suffers Operation at Baker Hospital Yesterday.

Arthur Oliver of Powder valley, who is a brother of Jack Oliver, Turner Oliver, and who has other relatives in this city, lost one leg by amputation yesterday following a consultation between physicians regarding his condition. Dr. Mollitor of this city was called to Baker yesterday for this purpose and it was found that amputation of the injured leg below the knee was absolutely necessary. Mr. Oliver rallied from the effects nicely.

Mr. Oliver was thrown from a horse recently and the breaks and crushed bones were more serious than at first

believed. He is about 44 years of age and has a family of a wife and several children. His home is 12 miles east of Baker.
