COVE JOINS IN CAMP GROUND IS BOOSTING PROVIDED

LOCAL MEN RETURN HAVING SEEN COVE BUSINESS MEN.

Increased Fruit Estimates Make Cove Well Pleased and Confident.

Cove will become a part and parcel of the two-county development scheme and will send a man here to represent Cove when the league is finally formed, according to local people who attended the informal meeting at Cove last evening. The La Grande Commercial club boosters went over to Cove in automobiles and met with whole hearted response from the business men and fruit men of that section. In the party were: S. D. Crowe, John Collier, George H. Currey, J. K. Wright, T. J. Scroggins, N. J. Manssager, O. E. Silverthorne, C. J. Black, S. M. Slough and Mr. Williams.

Cove Fruit Promising.
Cove, like other sections of the valley has found that its cherry crop is going to be much larger than was first believed and a good 50 per cent crop will be harvested. The fruit men are sanguine in their expectations now that developments are showing a fairly good crop prospect.

Cuteness of Madmen.

To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution adopted by the common council of the city of La Grande, Oregon on the 15th day of December, 1909, creating improvement district No. 13 and designating North Fir street, as such district, and in pursuance of a resolution adopted by said common council on the 3rd day of May, 1911, whereby said council determined and declared its intention to improve all that portion of North Fir street in said improvement district as hereinafter described, by laying thereon macadam roadway, the council will, ten days after the service of this notice upon the owners of the property affected and benefitted by such improvement, order that said above described improvement be made; that the boundaries said district to be so improved are as follows:

All that portion of North Fir street, from the south curb line of Monroe avenue, to the south line of Z avenue.

(A) And the property affected or benefitted by said improvement is as follows:

All the east halves of blocks 7, 6, 5, 4, 3 and 2, Predmore addition block 1, Predmore block and east halves of blocks 155, 150 and N. E. 1-4 of block 125, Chaplin's addition and the west halves of blocks 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23 and 24, Predmore addition and the west half of 154, 151 and 149, Chaplin's addition and N. W. 1-4 of block 124, Chaplin's addition, all in the city of La Grande, Oregon.

Notice is hereby further given that the council will levy a special assessment on all the property affected and benefitted by such improvement for the purpose of paying for such improvement. That the estimated cost of such improvement is the sum of \$14,780.00. That the council will, on the 7th day of June, 1911, meet at the council chamber at the hour of 8 o'clock p. m., to consider said estimated cost, and the levy of said assessment, when a hearing will be granted to any person feeling aggrieved by such assessment.

Arrangements Made for Having Camping Facilities Near Riverside.

Plans that will make a pleasant outing for many working people possible have been closed up between the chautauqua people and the owners of the Proebstel grove and the original scheme advanced last year but which fell through, as regards camping facilities, will be realized this year. Chautauqua visitors can camp on the Proebstel grove site and make a pleasant ten-day camping venture work in conjunction with the chautauqua. The contract has been closed up so that there will be ample room for a small city of tents with good water facilities, just across the road from the chautauqua grounds. This was one of the pleasant side attractions last year and was so popular that there is no question but what all available space will be taken this year. It gives the wives and mothers opportunities to attend the sectional meetings on the chautauqua grounds and husbands and fathers can spend the nights near the scene of the chautauqua, thus being able to attend all evening meetings and at the same time enjoy an outing that might otherwise be denied.
