**GYPSUM PLASTER PLANT SOON**

**HUNTINGTON COUNTRY TO GET ESTABLISHMENT.**

Money is Ready for Institution Below Huntington; Cost, \$100,000.

A 200 ton gypsum plaster plant is to be erected at what is known as Buchanan spur on the Northwestern railroad, a few miles below Huntington and on Snake river, says the Baker Democrat.

The plant is to cost \$100,000 or more and when in operation will employ about 100 men.

The company back of the enterprise is what is known as the Acuma Cement and Plaster company of St. Louis, Mo., and upwards of 3,000 acres of land have been purchased by the company.

The deal for the land was negotiated by Mr. Frank Nelson, of Boise, on behalf of the owners, Major John H. Aikin, of Portland, John P. Hannon and C. K. Northey of Huntington and John L. Rand of Baker.

The operation of the plant is a matter of the near future and will open up a splendid industry.

**Notice of Street Improvement.**

To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution adopted by the common council of the city of La Grande, Oregon on the 15th day of December, 1909, creating improvement district No. 13 and designating North Fir street, as such district, and in pursuance of a resolution adopted by said common council on the 3rd day of May, 1911, whereby said council determined and declared its intention to improve all that portion of North Fir street in said improvement district as hereinafter described, by laying thereon macadam roadway, the council will, ten days after the service of this notice upon the owners of the property affected and benefitted by such improvement, order that said above described improvement be made; that the boundaries said district to be so improved are as follows:

All that portion of North Fir street, from the south curb line of Monroe avenue, to the south line of Z avenue.

(A) And the property affected or benefitted by said improvement is as follows:

All the east halves of blocks 7, 6, 5, 4, 3 and 2, Predmore addition block 1, Predmore block and east halves of blocks 155, 150 and N. E. 1-4 of block 125, Chaplin's addition and the west halves of blocks 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23 and 24, Predmore addition and the
