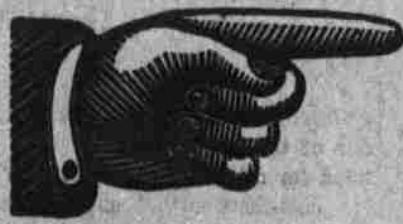

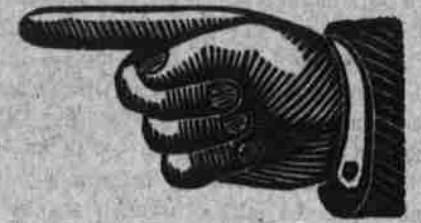

#### British Soldiers at Bunker Hill.

St. John, N. B., June 16.—The St. John Fusiliers, comprising the 62nd regiment, 300 strong, left here by special train today for Boston to take part in the Bunker Hill day celebration tomorrow. The regiment is in command of Col. J. L. McAvity and is accompanied by the regimental band and drum and bugle corps. The soldiers will remain in Boston several days and during their stay they will be the guests of the Massachusetts Volunteer militia.

#### Baptist Young People to Meet.

Oakland, Cal., June 16.—Oakland churches of many denominations have joined in the arrangements for entertaining the scores of visitors who will be here during the next three days for the Pacific coast convention of the Baptist Young People's societies. Many of the delegates have already arrived in the city. All of the Pacific states and British Columbia will be represented at the convention. The sessions will begin tomorrow and continue until Tuesday. Among the notable speakers will be Rev. J. R. Sampson of the Southern Baptist theological seminary, W. N. Hartshorn of the International Sunday school association, Dr. Brougher of Los Angeles and Prof. Ira M. Price of the university of Chicago.

#### Students' Y. M. C. A. Conference.

Portland, June 16.—A students' conference under the auspices of the International Young Men's Christian associations of the northwest opened at Columbia Beach today with a representation of 30 colleges of Oregon, Washington, Montana and Idaho. The conference is the largest gathering of its kind that has ever been held in this section of the country. The sessions will continue ten days.
