What is generally conceded to be the most valuable draft type or colt ever foaled in Union county is in possession of Willis Moss, of Moss, chartered district today, and it is doubtful if an even \$1,000 would buy the little fellow. **ORDINANCE NO. 525, SERIES 1911.**

The property described in section 1 and the enclosure thereon or building thereon are hereby created a city pound and the poundmaster of the city of La Grande is hereby directed and authorized to compound any animals therein under existing ordinance, in the manner and as the same was compounded in other city pounds within said city.
