Ordinance No. 536, Series 1911
An ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of Improvement Bonds for bonded assessments in Improvement Districts No. 5 in the time and manner described by the provisions of Sections 3245 to 3253 inclusive, and all amendments thereof of Lord's Oregon Laws, for the purpose of paying for the improvement of Fourth street including all portions thereof between the North line of Adams avenue and the South line of "O" avenue in the City of La Grande, Oregon.

Whereas, the city of La Grande by a resolution passed by the council on the 28th day of September, 1910 deemed it expedient and necessary to improve the following portions of Fourth street in the city of La Grande, Oregon, to-wit:
Fourth street from the south line of "O" avenue, and afterwards by an appropriate resolution caused the city engineer to prepare plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement; and

Whereas, said plans and specifications were duly prepared by said engineer for Fourth street between the north line of Adams avenue and the south line of "O" avenue and adopted and filed on the 28th day of September 1910, and ever since said dates have been and now are on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of La Grande, Oregon; and

Whereas, by the adoption of said plans and specifications on the aforesaid date, said council found the same to be satisfactory, and duly passes a resolution approving the same, and the boundaries of the districts benefited and to be assessed for such improvements were fixed by resolution as follows:

All of the portion of Fourth street from the north line of Adams avenue to the south line of "O" avenue, which said resolution was passed on the 28th day of September, 1910; and

Whereas, said council by said resolution last aforesaid declared its purpose to make improvement, and on the 28th day of September, 1910 appointed the 12th day of October, 1910 at 8 o'clock p. m., at the Council Chambers in said city as the time and place when and where said council would meet for the consideration of written remonstrances against the making of such proposed improvement and hearing the cause of any person feeling aggrieved thereby; and

Whereas, the Recorder of the City of La Grande gave notice of the time and place when the Council would meet for the consideration of such written remonstrances and complaints of persons feeling aggrieved on account of such improvement in the manner prescribed by law, to-wit:—

By causing a personal notice, as far as possible, to be served upon the property owners, agents or persons in charge of the property affected or

benefited by such improvements, proof of which notice is filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of La Grande, on the 18th day of November, 1910, and by the publication of said notice in the La Grande Evening Observer for the full period of ten (10) consecutive issues, beginning with the issue of the 30th day of September, 1910, and ending with the issue of the 11th day of October, 1910 proof of which is filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of La Grande, said notices described generally the street or portions thereof proposed to be improved and referred to the character of the improvement and also described generally the property within the assessment district; and

Whereas, the Council of said city met at the Council Chambers in the City of La Grande on the day and at the hour provided for said hearing on said proposed improvements, and at said meeting there was no written objection to such proposed improvement nor did any person appear who felt aggrieved thereby, and the city council of the City of La Grande was thereby deemed to have acquired jurisdiction to make said improvement, and the city council thereupon, by resolution, instructed the Recorder of the City of La Grande to advertise for bids for said improvements as follows:

For Fourth street between the north line of Adams avenue and the south line of "O" avenue, by publishing a notice to contractors for five (5) issues in the La Grande Evening Observer, a daily newspaper published in the city of La Grande, beginning with the issue of the 19th of October, 1910, and ending with the issue of the 26th day of October, 1910, proof of which is filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of La Grande; on November 16, 1910, by the terms of said notice proposals for the making such improvements according to the plans and specifications filed in the office of the City Recorder of the City of La Grande were invited and specified a time within which sealed bids may be filed in his office for the making of said improvement; and

Whereas, within said time a bid was received and duly accepted; and

Whereas, such proceedings were thereafter duly had in the premises that an ordinance was duly and regularly passed authorizing the Mayor and Recorder to enter into a contract for the improvement of said Fourth street heretofore mentioned in accordance with said plans and specifications; and

Whereas, said work provided for in said contract was completed and accepted by the city of La Grande; the Council by resolution determined the cost of making such improvement and duly met and considered and completed the assessment to cover the cost of said proposed improvement and did apportion the costs and expenses of said improvement upon and among the several parcels of property affected and benefited thereby, and in so case did such assessment exceed such benefits, and

Whereas, the said Council after having apportioned the cost and expense of such improvement upon the property bounding, abutting, fronting, contiguous, adjacent and tributary to such improvement declared the same by ordinance and directed the Recorder of the City of La Grande to enter a statement thereof in the docket of City Liens, and which ordinance referred to is:

Ordinance No. 529, Series 1911, entitled "an ordinance declaring the cost of improving Fourth street from the north line of Adams avenue to the south line of "O" avenue, determining the property benefited thereby, levying an assessment thereon to defray the costs and expenses of improvement; providing for the assessment roll in accordance with the assessment herein levied and to collect said assessment." Passed by the council of the city of La Grande on the 24th day of May, 1911, and approved by the Mayor on the 27th day of May, 1911; and

Whereas, the Recorder of the City of La Grande did thereafter enter a statement of such assessment in the docket of City Liens of the City of La Grande, and gave notice thereof to all property owners whose property is assessed by publication thereof in five (5) issues of the city official newspaper, to-wit: the La Grande Evening Observer, beginning with the issue of the 1st day of June, 1911, and ending with the issue of the 6th day of June, 1911, proof of publication of which notice is now on file in the office of the Recorder of said city; and among other things said

property owners were notified that said assessments could be paid in installments upon their making and filing an application therefor under the provisions of Sections 3245 and 3253 inclusive of Lord's Oregon Laws; and

Whereas, among other parcels of property directly benefited by said improvement and included within aid assessment districts, and the owners thereof the following have made and filed with the Recorder of the City of La Grande such applications and a list thereof, together with the names of the owners of said property a description of the property and the amount apportioned against each lot or part thereof or other parcel of and within such assessment district, is as follows, to-wit:
