SYLVAN ECHOES HEARD

REV. UPTON H. GIBBS PUBLISHES A NEW BOOK.

Reprinted in Book Form From Theses in Church Publication.

"Aftermath from a Sylvan Retreat," a followup of "Leaves of a Sylvan Retreat," published by Rev. Upton H. Gibbs in this city two years, has just been taken off the press at Milwaukee, Wis., in book form after it has been run in serial form in "The Living Church," an Episcopal publication. Rev. Gibbs, rector of the local Episcopal church, is the author of the "Aftermath" and following up the happy style and nature study that was commenced in the original "Sylvan Retreat." The first publication met with a great deal of favorable comment when it was published here two or three years ago, and goodly portions of it were published in "The Living Church." Last winter Rev. Gibbs continued his work and now has the compositions in book form which he is distributing among his friends. As was true of the original works, the setting of the "Aftermath" lies in and about Clearwater, Minn., and it is while on an imaginary fishing trip among the reeds of the lakes out from that city that the setting is placed for the initial chapter, entitled "Sunrise—Sunsum Corda."

"Sandprints" is the title of the second canto, "Summer Visitors," "Among the Vegetables," "Life and the Sanctuary—Its Regeneration," "Life and the Sanctuary—Its Honorable Estate," "Life and the Sanctuary—Its Valediction," "Sunset—Ringing to Evensong"—such are some of the titles of the theses treated in a very happy simple vein and style that are easily up to the finish and literary perfection of the original "Leaves of a Sylvan Retreat."

WATER FAMINE THREATENED.

Pendleton Supply Short During Extreme Hot Wave.

It has just become known that during the two hottest days Pendleton has experienced in six years that the town was threatened with a serious water

famine, relates the Pendleton Live Wire. Now that the danger is past the news has been allowed to leak out.

The trouble was due to the failure of the electric motor at the pumping plant to work properly. Fortunately the reservoir was well filled when the trouble started or the shortage would have been felt worse than it was and the general public could not have been kept in ignorance of the condition.

As it was the sprinklers were called off the streets for half a day and the track at Round-Up park was compelled to go waterless at a time when it was needed the most. Everything is now running smoothly at the plant and it is not believed there is any more danger of a serious water famine than the city has experienced every year.

Lord Elgin Centenary.

London, July 20.—Some of the London newspapers today recalled the fact that this is the 100th anniversary of the birth of the Earl of Elgin, who was one of the most successful diplomats in the history of Great Britain. As governor general of Canada for eight years from 1846, the quiet success of his policy in meeting an unusually sensitive condition, marked him for a man of administrative tact amounting to genius. He was but 34 years old when appointed governor general, but he had already had several years of experience as governor of Jamaica. Long before his term of service expired he was the most popular man in Canada, and had carried out a policy that was so universally satisfactory that, when he returned to England, he was raised to the British peerage, his former title having been a Scottish one. Lord Elgin's death occurred in 1863, while he was serving as governor general of India.

Railway Foremen to Meet.

Chicago, Ill., July 20.—Preparations have been completed for the entertainment of the International Railway General Foremen's association, which will meet in annual convention in this city during three days next week. The meeting will be attended by representatives of many of the leading railroads of the United States, Canada and Mexico.
