TELEGRAMS SHOULD BE SENT TO STATE FORESTER,

Many Fires Not Reported in Time to Prevent Much Damage.

The state forester advists the Observer that he is constantly getting notice through the daily press and from residents of the state of fires having gotten beyond control after several days' fighting, that have not been reported to his office until after becoming a menace to the neighborhood. He wishes to urge upon all the state fire wardens the necessity of repor ing to him all fires as soon after beng discovered as possible, instead of waiting until they become dangerably entirely extinguished if reported earlier so that proper assistance could have been given.

Evry state fire warden, or other perons, in case they are unable to get in touch with a state warden, should telphone or telegraph (collect) F. A. Elliott, state forester, Salem, Oregon. informing him of forest fires before they get beyond control.
