BALLAST ROAD TO THE SUMMIT

NEW BRIDGE ACROSS RIVER FOR THIS PURPOSE.

Gravel Will Be Secured From Beds Lying Near the River.

Everything is in readiness for the rebalasting of the main line roadbed from La Grande to Kamela. The O. W. has constructed a bridge across the Grande Ronde river at the Palmer mill and has installed its steam shovel in the gravel pit here, and it will supply the necessary gravel for the repair of the track up to the summit.

Extra gangs will be put to work tomorrow morning so that the ballasting can proceed without any hitch. The work was to have commenced today but the rain yesterday retarded the setting up of the steam shovel.

The pit was reached only after considerable preparation. The company built its extension across the river so that the big gravel beds could be reached without any loss of time, and the preparatory work has consumed considerable time.

ELLIS SILENT ON TOGA RACE

SAYS HE DID NOT AUTHORIZE ITS PUBLICATION.

Will Neither Confirm or Deny the Report at This Time.

Hon. W. R. Ellis has not authorized publication of the statement that he would be a candidate to succeed Jonathan Bourne, Jr., which statement made its appearance in Portland papers a few days ago. The Live Wire of Pendleton publishes the following interview with the ex-congressman yesterday:

"I neither confirm nor deny any newspaper reports of my candidacy for this or that office," declared former Congressman W. R. Ellis this afternoon. The judge has just returned from a successful fishing trip with his son, Ed Ellis, to the Deschutes river. "I never authorize any of these reports and I never pay any attention to them," continued the former member of congress. "They can nominate me for the presidency if they so desire."

When asked as to his present or future plan, he said he had none. Apparently he is enjoying his vacation to the fullest extent and is taking advantage of the opportunity to look after his private interests, which have been somewhat neglected in the past few years on account of his public duties.

In speaking the announcement in yesterday's Oregonian and the Live Wire, Judge Ellis said he had not been in Portland for more than a week and had not seen a newspaper man to talk to him for a month.

Corinthians Start American Tour.

Toronto, Ont., August 4.—The famous Corinthian football team of England will begin its American tour here tomorrow with a game against a picked team made up of the best soccer players of Toronto. From this city the Corinthians will go to Hamilton for a game Monday and on Wednesday will return here for a second game. Montreal is on the schedule for Saturday of next week and from that point the Corinthians will begin a tour of Canada that will take them as far as Vancouver and Victoria. On the return journey the visitors will make a digression into the United States, where games have been scheduled for Chicago, St. Louis, Philadelphia and one or two other places.

New York to Camden Race.

New York, August 4.—Under the auspices of the New York Motor Boat club a race for cruising craft of 30 to 50 feet in length was started from this city today, with Camden, N. J., as the objective point. The course lies around Sandy Hook and down the New Jersey coast to Cape May and thence up the Delaware river to Camden.
