NOTICE OF STREET IMPROVEMENT TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution adopted by the common council of the city of La Grande, Oregon, on the 15th day of December, 1909, creating improvement district No. 13, and designating North Fir street, as such district, and in pursuance of a resolution adopted by said common council on the 28th day of June, 1911, whereby said council determined and declared its intention to improve all that portion of North Fir street, in said improvement district as hereinafter described, by constructing cement walks on each side of street, the council will, ten days after the service of this notice upon the owners of the property affected and benefited by such improvement, order that said above described improvement be made; that the boundaries of said district to be so improved are as follows:

All that portion of North Fir street from the north curb line of Monroe avenue, to the south side of W avenue.

(A) And the property affected or benefited by said improvement is as follows:

Lots 7 and 8, block 150; lots 13 and 14, block 151; lots 1 and 26, block 154, and lots 1 and 26, block 151; Chaplin's addition and lot 13, Predmore block and lots 13 and 14, block 2.

NEW CAMPFIRE REGULATIONS

STATE FIRE AND FORESTRY BOARD ISSUES EDICT.

Carelessness Causes New Enactment of Resolutions Governing Fire.

Salem, Ore., Aug. 9.—(Special)—At a meeting held in Portland August 5 the state board of forestry again cautioned the state fire wardens in regard to issuing burning permits and passed the following resolutions prescribing the conditions under which burning without a permit may be done:

"Whereas, Section 7, of Oregon's Forest Fire Law provides that 'burning of log piles, stumps, or brush heaps in small quantities, under adequate precautions and personal control and in accordance with any regulations which may be adopted by the state board of forestry for the purpose of insuring public safety,' is permissible; and

"Whereas, instances have occurred which tend to show that this section has been taken advantage of to burn in a manner not intended by the law, and public safety as well as private property has been endangered thereby; and

"Whereas, the law empowers the state board of forestry to prescribe the conditions under which such burning can be done; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That the following regulations governing burning without a permit be effective on and after August 10, 1911, and that these regulations be given publicity through the press and by means of posted notices:

"1. Burning of log piles, stumps, or brush heaps without permit as provided for under section 7 of the Oregon Forest Fire Law, is permissible only where the material to be burned is a safe distance from other inflammable material and where the ground surrounding the log piles, stumps, or brush heaps is cleared of any substance which will allow of fire spreading to adjacent wooded, brush, or slash-covered land, either the property of the parties engaged in burning or that of another.

"2. 'Adequate precautions and personal control' is interpreted as meaning that all fire set without permit must be continually watched both night and day by a sufficient number of men on the ground for that purpose, and should fire escape steps must be taken at once to extinguish it.

"3. Burning done in violation of these regulations will submit the party or parties concerned to prosecution under the fire laws."
