## MARSHAL ON HIS WAY HERE

ALLEGED WHITE SLAVER TO BE TAKEN TO PORTLAND.

United States District Attorney McCourt Sanctions Arrest.

After being in conversation with United States District Attorney McCourt at Portland yesterday over the long distance wires, Chief of Police Walden announced today that a United States marshal will arrive in La Grande tonight or tomorrow morning to take charge of Chris Louis, the Greek held in the county jail on a charge of white slavery and Mrs. Dillman, the "slave" held in the city jail. When the facts in the case were presented to Mr. McCourt, he readily consented to the marshal's coming and the prisoners will be taken to Portland at once. As the charges relate to federal laws, the trial will have to be held before the United States circuit court at Portland and not in the local court. Mrs. Dillman will, of course, be held as a witness only and not as a partner or accessory in the alleged crime.

Since the publication of the alleged slavery yoke applied to the Pendleton woman, local people have complimented Chief of Police Walden for his success in running the accused to cover and if Louis is found guilty it is hoped that his punishment will be swift and sufficient. The spread of white slavery from the centers of population to smaller towns has alarmed police and public alike and that the officers should be lent public moral support in the fight against trafficking in women is the opinion of everyone interested.

## BEETLES WORK ON WATER SHED

BEAVER CREEK'S PROTECTION IS HOME OF BEETLES.

Area Covered Much Larger Than Last Year—Serious Aspect Seen.

Beetles are working destructive havoc with the forests on Beaver creek's water shed, and the area swept by the deadly beetle has ground with surprising rapidity the past year, according to Water Superintendent L. M. Hoyt who returned Saturday evening from Beaver Creek where for more than a week he fought the forest fire there, preventing its reaching the beetle-swept area of Beaver creek's water shed. The fire is still in control and burning itself out, but while there Mr. Hoyt inspected the timber protecting Beaver creek and found that the area smitten by the destructive beetle is much greater than last year. From a prominence he could gain a clear view of the entire shed and it was genuinely surprised at the extent of the "dead" timber, killed by the beetle, which government forces are fighting everywhere. The big pines are left in a "dead" condition when the beetle finishes its work and leaves the area susceptible to fire.

Because the timber is thus being killed off, the danger of fire in the water shed, to that it might menace the La Grande water supply, is becoming more and more serious.

A small crew of men is still at the scene of the fire.

## LOCAL SAVANTS LOCATE COMET

BROOKS' COMET FOUND THROUGH LOCAL TELESCOPE.

Newly-Found Tramp of the Heavens Draws Nearer and Grows Bright.

Brook's comet, a new and strange celestial wanderer, discovered and named a few days ago by Prof. Brooks of Hobart college, Geneva, N. Y., was distinctly seen here Saturday night through the telescope owned by Perry Oliver and others, and purchased at the time Halley's comet was the center of attraction. As far as can be ascertained, this is the first time the comet has been seen by western people, at least the first time seen by amateur savants. Prof. Brooks discovered it and in the east the comet is soon to be visible to the naked eye because it is coming constantly nearer to the earth. As yet it cannot be seen by the naked eye here, but through the powerful lenses of the telescope the comet is a pretty sight. Either the tail—if there is one—is pointing almost directly toward earth or directly away from it for the tramp is almost round, though a little oval, and has its nucleus to one side of the center. Perry Oliver, C. M. Humphreys and others who saw it Saturday night, are of the opinion that it is a tailless comet. Eastern news dispatches do not cover this question.

The comet must be seen early in the evening or late at night as it is almost directly overhead about 9 or 10 o'clock in the evening. It is near the constellation Cygnus.

As the comet approaches earth its journey will be closely watched by the local savants.
