Irish Players to Open Boston Theatre
Boston, Mass., Sept. 22.—The entire company of Irish players from the Abbey theatre, Dublin, has arrived in this city to begin their American tour. The beginning of the local engagement tomorrow night will also mark the opening and dedication of Boston's newest playhouse, the Plymouth theatre, which was recently completed for Liebler and company. The Irish players are accompanied to America by Lady Gregory, W. B. Yeats, the well-known Irish poet, and several others who are prominently interested in the movement to revive Irish literature and the drama.

BIG SHIPMENT OF SHEEP MADE

OVER 23,000 HEAD SENT OUT THIS WEEK.

Many Buyers Took Sheep From the Wallawa County Ranges.

(Enterprise News-Record.)
Over 23,000 head of sheep and lambs have been sold by Wallawa county wool growers the past week, nearly all to outside buyers, but more than half of them will be fattened for market in this valley before shipping.

Charles L. Buell of Chicago is the heaviest individual purchaser. He has bought to date 6,500 head of lambs from R. F. and Omar Stubblefield from Sam Litch contracting for Wm. Hanson, Lou Stumbaugh and L. F. & H. company. The price paid is \$3.50 a hundred making about \$2.25 a head. These lambs will be fed in the valley if Mr. Buell can buy his hay reasonable, otherwise they will be shipped to Twin Falls. He would prefer to feed here on account of the better pasturage and climate. Buell's purchases are in addition to the 10,000 head bought 10 days ago by McCully & Pumble and that will also be fed in here.

Charles Hale of Walla Walla, Wash., has bought 1400 head of yearling wethers from C. P. Ragadale, 900 from Sam Litch and 2500 from J. H. Dobbin at around \$2.25 a head. Mr. Dobbin has also sold 1400 head of the same class to Al Jones. Mr. Hale is still here and will probably make further purchases.

Col. E. J. Bell, noted stockman, capitalist and raconteur of Laramie, Wyo., has been delighting the stockmen with a visit and some of his inimitable stories. He also, incidentally, has bought a few sheep in here. 2,000 two and three year old ewes of F. D. McCully at \$3.50 a head and 3,000 ewes, including some yearlings from R. F. Stubblefield. Like Mr. Hale he is still here and looking at different bands. Mr. Bell has already bought 13,000 ewes on this trip, 8,000 in Baker and some in Union county.

May Not Prosecute Woman.
Chicago, Ill., Sept. 22.—Mrs. Harriet Coner, who two weeks ago shot and seriously wounded Robert Bruce Watson, prominent architect and clubman, was arraigned in court today for a preliminary hearing. Mr. Watson has about recovered from the effects of his wounds. According to Mrs. Coner's story the shooting was the result of Watson's determination to sever their relations, which, it is alleged, caused the divorce of Mrs. Coner and her husband. The woman's attorneys express the opinion that Watson will not prosecute the case and that ultimately Mrs. Coner will be released without trial.
