### DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS ELECTED

Shareholders Pay \$35 Each and Pay Monthly Toll to Company.

Organization of an independent telephone company to operate in and about Elgin was perfected at Elgin yesterday.

With the election of officers and a board of directors to handle the new company. The company is organized on a no-dividend basis and each shareholder is taxed \$35 and in addition must pay 50 cents per month for the maintenance of the telephone. ### GIRL IS SLASHED WITH RAZOR.

New York Girl Refuses to Tell Where bout of Cola and Jewelry and Thieves Beat Her.

New York, Sept. 29.—Emma Mauer-mann, 16 years old, was tortured, bound, gagged, beaten and slashed with a razor by thugs in her home at 169 West Ninety-ninth street in an effort to force her to reveal the place where her parents had concealed their savings.

The facts in the violent attack on the girl were learned today, although the police have maintained a secrecy as to the crime in the hopes that they would be able to obtain some clue to the thieves and assailants. The girl is slowly recovering from the beating and slashing that she received at the hands of the robbers but as yet she is extremely nervous.

The young woman was struck with heavy fists, and when it was seen she would not give the robbers any information, she was bound and gagged with a bed sheet which was taken from her bed. A towel was fastened over her mouth and while she lay helpless on the floor, one of the thugs entered the room with a razor, which he flourished before the girl's eyes. She instinctively flinched but did not show any signs of yielding. It was only after the pair of thugs became exasperated at what they believed to be her obstinacy of the young woman that one of them drew the razor several times across the cheek of the half fainting young woman.

The girl was tied fast in the bedroom and the gag fastened so that she

could not possibly give an outcry and while the thieves ransacked the flat she tried to keep her senses and at the same time she continued a struggle with her bonds.

The robbers made short work of the flat and rapidly went through all of the bureaus, closets and chests in the place. Then they started in on the beds and under a mattress on the bed

which was occupied by the father and mother of the young woman they discovered a roll of bills amounting to \$218.

It was apparent that this was the money that they were after, because as soon as they got their hands on the roll they fled from the flat without taking the trouble to see if the young woman was still alive.
