FAIR CONCERT DELIGHTS 500

VOCAL, ORGAN AND CHORUS NUMBERS EDIFYING.

Nearly Five Hundred Hear Splendid Program Last Evening.

Much of La Grande's best in music—vocal, instrumental and chorus—was heard to the edification of between 400 and 500 at the L. D. S. tabernacle last night when the county fair board gave to the public a program of extraordinary worth. It was a sacred concert and every number was in harmony with the title.

Not only were vocal and chorus numbers exceptionally well rendered but four pipe organ numbers entertained an audience which still remembers that master, Prof. McClellan of Salt Lake and is critical because of it. Mrs. Eria Carllock and J. Frank Maguire each operated the organ with finis and deftness. Too such pipe organists are not often found in a city of La Grande's size and preclude the necessity of bringing artists here from other cities.

The L. D. S. chorus of some 60 voices under the direction of W. K. Davis with C. P. Ferrin as soloist was no small part of the evening's entertainment for four numbers were well rendered by the chorus. C. P. Ferrin, W. K. Davis, Mrs. A. L. Richardson, Mrs. Jay Van Buren and Mrs. A. S. Geddes were the soloists of the evening and made it possible for the fair board to give to a La Grande audience without special drilling and great preparation a series of musical numbers of stellar worth and seldom emulated in much larger cities.
