JURY FINDS FOR BRICHOUX

TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS AND FEES IS VERDICT.

Case Comes to an End Late Last Evening When Verdict Is Reached.

Two hundred dollars with interest at eight per cent from January 1st, 1911, until the present date and an additional sum of \$40 for attorney's fees was the sum allowed D. C. Brichoux in a jury decision reached at 6 o'clock last evening. The jury had been deliberating about four hours when it reached its agreement and the Spain case was halted last evening for a few minutes that the jury's verdict might be reported in.

The sum represents fees for locating two claims, one for Mason Bullard and one for Nellie Bullard, both of this city. D. C. Brichoux was the complaining witness.

Tablet to First Presid^{nt}.

Washington, Oct. 6.—In the picturesque village of Falls Church, Va., nine miles from this city, a marble tablet placed upon the outer wall of the Old Falls Church edifice in honor of Geo. Washington, was unveiled today with exercises conducted by the town chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution. Gen. Washington served for 20 years as warden and vestryman of the church, which is one of the oldest and most historic in this section of the country. The first church building is believed to have been erected about 1709, while the present edifice was built in 1734 with material which was brought from England.

Women to Watch Polls.

San Francisco, Oct. 6.—The suffragette organization today is arranging to have 4,000 women watch the polls on Oct. 10 when the state wide primaries and a number of constitutional amendments, including the proposition of equal suffrage will be voted on.

It is believed that this number will be necessary to enable the women to work in shift from 6 a. m. to 6 p. m. They will follow out the plan of the Washington suffragettes of distributing suffrage literature in the vicinity of the polls, which was very successful in the northern state.

Talk Across Pacific.

San Francisco, Oct. 6.—Wireless has conquered the Pacific. A San Francisco operator in the United Wireless station at Hillcrest got into communication with the Japanese operator in the Join station at Otsu on the island of Hokushu. Although they were separated by 6,000 miles of water they exchanged greetings and talked for 15 minutes before atmospheric changes caused communication to be cut off.
