LADY FEARS THE STRIKERS

CALLS POLICE WHEN MEN LIFT
HATS TO COUPLE.

So-Called Strikebreaker and Lady
Friend Given Salute From Men

Because a crowd of strikers yesterday afternoon doffed their hats to a man said to be a strikebreaker and accompanied by a lady, the police were called to protect the couple. When the details were explained to the officers, however, the fears of the lady and her escort were allayed for they were informed that the men who were in the group that saluted, politely enough, but probably actuated by irony, were citizens of La Grande and would not insult or injure the lady in any way. The salutation was done on Adams avenue as the policeman was near at the time. After a short consultation the so-called strikebreaker and the lady turned up Depot and went to the residence district.

The strikers today said there was no harm intended or insult aimed at the lady in any way, but seeing the man approach and knowing or believing him to be a strikebreaker, they suavely and politely lifted their hats to the couple as they passed. The strikers deny that their pickets had been following the two about the streets, which the lady said was a fact.

NOTICE OF STREET IMPROVEMENT

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution adopted by the common council of the city of La Grande, Oregon, on the 5th day of August, 1909 creating improvement district No. 2, and designating Third street, as such district and in pursuance of a resolution adopted by said common council on the 6th day of September, 1911, whereby said council determined and declared its intention to improve all that portion of Third street, in said improvement district as hereinafter described, by laying thereon cement curb on both sides of street, the council will, ten days after the service of this notice upon the owners of the property affected and benefited by such improvement, order that said above described improvement be made; that the boundaries of said district to be so improved are as follows:

All that portion of Third street, from the south curb line of Jefferson avenue to the north curb line of Main avenue.

(A) And the property affected or benefited by said improvement is as follows:

The west half of blocks 1, 2 and 3 and the east half of blocks 7, 8 and 9, La Grande, Oregon.

Notice is hereby further given that the council will levy a special assessment on all the property affected and benefited by such improvement for the purpose of paying for such improvement. That the estimated cost of such improvement is the sum of \$784.50. That the council will, on the 18th day of October, 1911, meet at the council to consider said estimated cost, and the levy of said assessment, when a hearing will be granted to any person feeling aggrieved by such assessment.
