CAR SHEDS TO BE BUILT HERE

UMBRELLA SHEDS TO COVER RIP TRACK.

Four Hundred and Fifty Feet Long and Wide Enough for Two Tracks.

Umbrella car sheds to cover a large portion of the rip track in the La Grande yards will be constructed at once. Building Inspector G. H. Loring is in the city from Portland looking after preliminary work. Material will be on the ground this week and construction will start at once.

To Cover Two Tracks.

The structure will be 495 feet long and will cover two tracks with roof extension to keep the tracks and cars perfectly dry when in for repairs.

The rip track crew has always been required to work in the open and storm has been a menace to the best results especially in the winter months. The shed will allow the company to run the bad order cars into the shed and keep them there until they are repaired and workmen will not be harassed with storms.

FORESTRY BOARD VISITS COUNTY

RECENTLY CREATED BOARD JUNCTS THROUGH COUNTY.

Elliott, Head of Board, and Hill, a Member, Make up Party.

Two members of the state board of forestry were in La Grande this morning, on their way from Baker, where they visited yesterday to Elgin and Wallowa county. F. A. Elliott, the head of the board, and a resident of Salem, and L. S. Hill, of Portland, the other member, make up the party.

Yesterday they completed a junket into the interior out from Baker and today commence a tour of inspection about the Elgin country and then into Wallowa.

It was largely this forestry board, created by the last legislature, that was responsible for the great decrease in forest fires for their campaign to educate the public and their vigilance when fire did break out, stood for the protection of a great deal of timber. A well organized corps of assistants made it possible for the board to quench most of the fires before they got under way.

After a careful investigation of affairs along the branch line the men will return to La Grande for a brief visit.

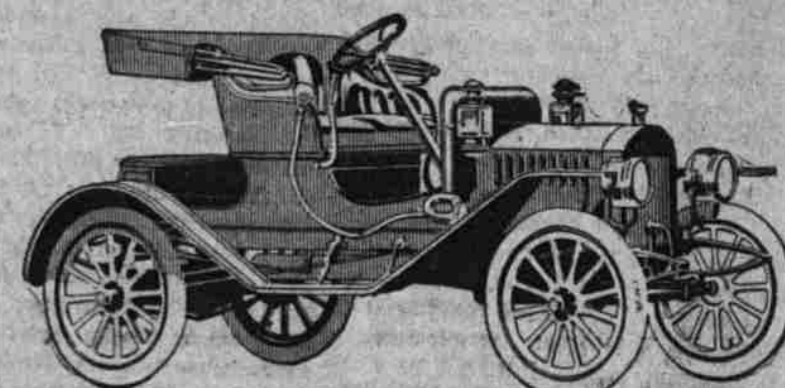
