WET AND DRY CAMPAIGN ON

JOSEPH BUSINESS MEN CONSIDERING COMING ELECTION.

Considerable Discussion Over Pending City Election There.

Joseph, Ore., Oct. 26.—(Special) — With the approaching election near at hand, considerable discussion is being had here regarding whether or not the town will vote "wet" or "dry." The majority of the business men seem to favor a "wet" town under strict regulation.

A petition is being circulated among the business men and citizens of Joseph asking that the light which were discontinued recently, be turned on again, and unless the same are restored before election it is the opinion of many that this may enter the campaign.

Joseph is the only town in Wallawa county that took advantage of the local option law and voted "wet" at the last election, but owing to a number of technicalities have thus far been unable to grant a license to sell liquor.
