SCIENTIFIC GROWING PAYS

APPLE DEMAND CLEARLY EMPHASIZES THE POINT.

Northwestern Fruit Exchange Tells of Market Conditions.

(By Northwestern Fruit Exchange.)

Portland, Ore., Oct. 27.—(Special)—Apples—The market situation is clear cut and sharply defined. There is a strong demand for extra fancy and fancy grades of strictly well packed, well graded, well colored fruit of large sizes, 3 1/2 and 4 tier. For poor grades, poor to fair color or pack, and for small sizes, 2 1/2 and 3 tier, the demand is feeble or wholly lacking.

One thing, above every other, has been emphasized by the experience of this year, viz.: that strictly fine fruit, which has been scientifically grown, and handled with painstaking care from tree to car, and then marketed in scientific manner, will return profitable prices to the producer under even the most adverse market conditions. On the other hand, growers may as well face the fact that the outlook is growing continually more unpromising for medium to poor fruit, indifferently handled. It is up to the growers themselves.
