60 PER CENT CAN HALT PROGRESS

PENDLETON PEOPLE WILL ACT ON COMMISSION PLAN

Sixty Per Cent Can Remonstrate Effectively Against Improvement.

Dealing with the charter amendment question the Pendleton East Oregonian says:

If the people of the city adopt the commission plan charter which has been submitted to them under the initiative by the Progressive Non-partisan Municipal league, they will enact one clause that will be pleasing to property owners who object to the provision of the old charter that requires a remonstrance signed by 80 per cent of the property owners of a street to block proposed improvements.

Under the charter submitted by the Progressive league it is specified that 60 per cent of the property owners on a street or in an improvement district may demonstrate against an improvement. When this subject was before the league it was announced that the suggestion for a reduction on the number of remonstrators came from Mayor Murphy. It was also set forth that at times the 80 per cent provision now in force may work injustice.

The petitions calling for the submission of the Progressive league's charter were duly filed Saturday evening and in compliance with the petitions the commission plan of government will be voted upon by the people at the election to be held in December.

Should the commission plan of government be adopted a special election will be held in February to elect a mayor and two commissioners to manage the affairs of the city.

Notice is hereby further given that the council will levy a special assessment on all the property affected and benefited by such improvement for the purpose of paying for such improvement. That the estimated cost of such improvement is the sum of \$4,054.00.
