Bad blood existing between O.-W. strikers and strikebreakers in the local railroad shops cropped out again last night at Depot and Jefferson when a wrangling crowd gathered and obstructing the sidewalk, created a formity of action by the northwestern was responsible Officer McLachlen ordered the men to move on and all but one or two did so. That the United States government itself is cognizant of the efforts being made in this matter, and desires to assist, seems assured from the fact that no less a personage than Presi ! dent Taft has added his semi-official endorsement to the tour of the governors by formally inviting the party to visit him white en tour.

With the sole exception of Governor Hiram W. Johnson, of California, who, it is said, has called a special session of the legislature which will be in session at the time of the tour. each one of the chief executives of the ten states participating, will be on the special when it leaves St. Paul, on the evening of Nov. 27, on its memorable tour. Whether the hopes of its promoters and the good wishes of the western people will bear fruit, must be left to the near future, when a comparison of the immigration statistics will show whether the hordes of homeseekers will have been persuaded to develop their own country. or an allen one.
