**Maul Rock.**  
Among the numerous natural curiosities of West Virginia is one in Lincoln county called the "Maul rock" because of its similarity to a maul. The base of the rock is about a thousand feet above sea level and is made up of large bowlders, says an exchange. The stem of the rock is twenty feet high and will average about seven feet in diameter. The cap, or maul part, is about six feet thick and is thirty-eight feet in circumference. The stem is of a soft formation and is fast crumbling away, since the timber has died that was a great protection from the force of strong winds. By mounting the rock by means of a ladder that is kept there a magnificent view of the West Virginia hills can be obtained.—Christian Science Monitor.

### CHURCH FUNDS RAISED QUICKLY

**FOUR THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED RAISED IN A NIGHT.**  
Hope to Have Sum Total at \$15,000 in a Week's Time.

Active campaigning for funds with which to construct a \$30,000 or \$35,000 cathedral in this city has been launched and \$4,500 were realized at the first booster meeting at which 20 or 25 active men in the Catholic church participated this week. Within the next six days the sum will be brought to \$15,000 with moneys already on hand, it is believed, basing the statement on a percentage of men who have already subscribed. Permanent selection of a church site has been announced and the new structure is to stand on Fourth street opposite the old high school building. There is to be no let up in the work until enough funds have been subscribed to justify the commencement of construction. Prior to the big campaign for funds the church building fund already carried about \$1,000 and a lot valued at \$1,100 was owned so that the Catholics feel jubilant at the prospects of commencing construction of the new church edifice next spring. Enough money will be expended to make it one of the finest cathedrals in Eastern Oregon.

The building committee, each member of which has a subscription list, is working only the ranks of the congregation at this time and reports today say they are meeting with a great deal of success. The membership of the building committee reads: Rev. Father Driscoll, J. H. Pearce, F. I. Moran, W. E. Deacon, W. H. Casey, James Corbett and P. A. Foley.

### DEEPEST SLEEP.

It Always Occurs During the First Hour of Slumber.

"Yes," said the doctor, "sleep is a very puzzling mystery. Nobody knows what the cause of it is, but we do know that it is always accompanied by anaemia of the brain. In other words, when you sleep the blood drains away from the head to the limbs. If you fell asleep on a balanced bed, the moment you dropped off the foot of the bed would begin to sink, and the deeper the sleep the greater the slant.

"That is why a hot bath tends to sleepiness. It brings the blood to the skin and so lessens the supply to the brain. Curiously enough, great cold has the same effect and for the same reason. You know how cold swells and reddens the hands.

"Recent experiments have shown conclusively how pale and bloodless the brain grows in sleep. How? Well, a piece of bone has been removed from the skull of a puppy and a watchglass inserted instead. The moment the puppy under observation wakes its brain at once grows pink again. No; the puppy doesn't seem to mind it.

"Experiments made by dropping heavy balls have shown that sleep is always at its deepest in the first hour. After that unconsciousness gets shallower and shallower."—London Answers.
