**BUTTER STAYS AT 45 CENTS**

**RAISE OF BUTTER FAT NOT FELT LOCALLY.**

City Folks Still Able to Get Two Pounds for 85 Cents.  
 Yesterday's rise in butter fat has not reached the retail butter handlers today and the users can procure the regular two pound rolls for 85 cents or the one-pound roll for 45 cents. It is reported that if any rise was decided upon it would effect the two-pound rolls only, but for the present at least the dealers are willing to handle the commodity at little or no profit.
