Nation's Bankers Meet.

New Orleans, Nov. 21.—The American Bankers' association's 37th annual convention opened today with delegates representing 12,375 banks throughout the country, attending. The invocation was delivered by Archbishop Blenk and Mayor Behrmann gave the welcome address. President Watts submitted a report, strongly endorsing the reserve association plan of ex-Senator Aldrich, chairman of the national monetary commission.

Practically every speaker endorsed Watts' stand.

Aldrich, speaking in support of his new monetary banking plan, said "The failure of our monetary system is largely attributable to the inability of our banks to co-operate in times of stress and our defective, inelastic, unscientific system of note issues"

Then he concluded by saying his system would not compete with the existing banks but maintain the integrity of them.
