### LIQUOR CASES ARE EXPLAINED

SUPREME COURT COMMENTS ON APPEALED CASES.

Texas Law Borrowed by Oregon and Texas Precedent a Guide.

A news dispatch from Salem to a Portland paper deals more fully with the victories of L. Remillard and others before the supreme court relative to the appeal of their convictions for selling liquor when Union county was dry. Explaining the reversal the court says:

Two Union county local option cases were reversed in opinions by Justice Moore today, these being the cases of Victor Townsend and Dell Kennedy and L. Remillard. In the Townsend case the court in construing the local option law, says that it was patterned after the Texas law, and that it is a well known rule of construction in Oregon that when a law of this state is borrowed from the law of another state that its construction here will be similar to that applied by the court of the last resort in the state from which it was borrowed.

The appeal was grounded on failure to sustain a demurrer that the averment did not give facts sufficient to constitute a crime. "The failure to aver that an election had been held in Union county at which a majority of all the votes cast on that subject favored prohibition rendered the indictment inadequate in that it did not state facts sufficient to constitute a crime, and an error was committed in overruling the demurrer interposed on that ground," says the court. The same ruling was given in the Kennedy and Remillard case.

Among other cases decided, all reversals, were as follows:

George Palmer Lumber company appellant, vs. Wallowa County, respondent; appealed from Wallowa county. J. W. Knowles, judge; reversed in an opinion by Chief Justice Eakin. This was a proceeding to review the action of the county court of Wallowa county in laying out and establishing a road.

As arranged by those in charge of

affairs the coming convention will open on Monday evening, December 4, with a banquet which will be devoted to transacting business and to the election of state officers.

C. S. Barrett, of Georgia, national president of the farmers' union, is to be a guest at the meeting in Pendleton and his presence will add much interest to the gathering in view of his position.

At the first state meeting of the union held last year at The Dalles there were 250 in attendance. In the opinion of W. W. Harrah, prominent local member of the union, the attendance at the coming meeting in Pen-

denton will probably be as great or greater than at the first meeting.

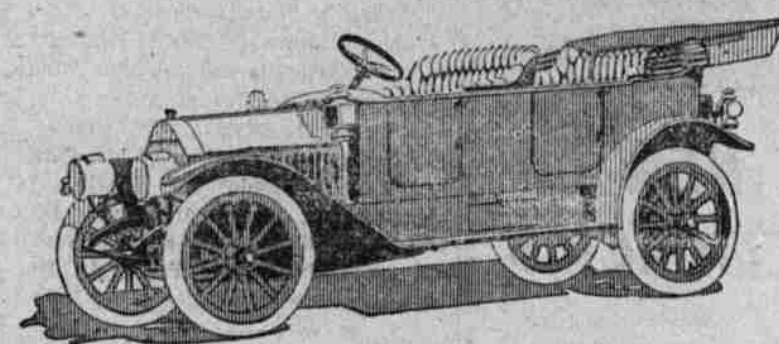
