

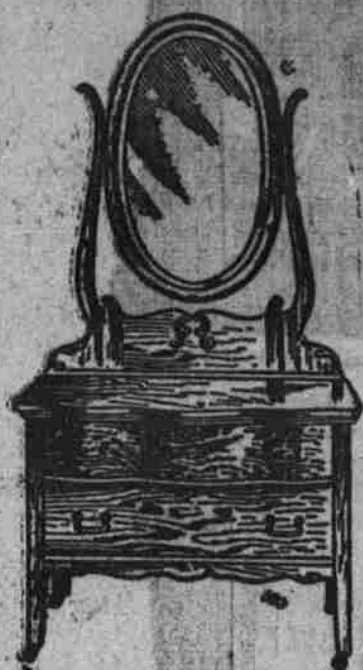

Third ward—Polling place, 2110 Fourth street. Judges: J. M. Hiltz, George Ledaworth, W. D. Grandy, Clarke Howard Davis and B. L. Leavitt.

Fourth ward—Polling place, new Harris building corner Monroe and Ohio Greenwood street. Judges: G. W. Allen, M. Shoney, J. H. Koshensperger. Clerks: John Ladd and W. A. Thompson.

Said election will be conducted and the returns provided by law in the case of general city elections of said city.

The polls of said election will be

opened at the hour of 8 o'clock a. m. and closed at the hour of 7 o'clock p. m. on said day.
