

GRAND JURORS END SESSIONS

NINE TRUE AND FIVE NOT TRUE BILLS.

No Arraignments Will Be Taken at This Time is Plan of Court.

Nine true bills and five not true bills comprise the gist of work transacted by the grand jury prior to its dismissal last Saturday evening. None of the indictments are made public and none will be arraigned is planned until Judge Knowles and the district attorney, F. S. Ivanhoe, return from Wallowa county where they are this week conducting several liquor case prosecutions. This will probably keep the indictments secret for a period of 10 days or more.

- Those who were exonerated were: State vs. James Baker, charged with rape by Elgin parties.
- State vs. John Doe Peterson, charged with burglary not in a dwelling.
- State vs. John Reeves, charged with larceny in a dwelling.
- State vs. J. C. Crawford, charged with giving intoxicating liquor to a minor.
- State vs. George Davis charged with burglary not in a dwelling house.
