LANDS SHOW BETTER VALUES

ASSESSMENT OF THE COUNTY IS MADE PUBLIC.

Aside From Corporations, Valuation Is Over Thirteen Millions.

Thirteen million, eight hundred and forty-two thousand, one hundred and thirty-five dollars is the assessed valuation of Union county outside of the property owned by corporations. Various items going to make up this total have been segregated and made known by County Assessor Dave Clark. This figure is virtually a very large increase over last year because of the fact that the much mooted topic of notes and accounts does not enter into the totals as it did last year, to the tune of \$100,000 or so. telephones and sawmills must yet be added. Notwithstanding the lack of this item the county's wealth has increased a total of \$134,500.

Orchard Land Responsible.

The item that has raised the valuation chiefly is the orchard. The hundreds of acres of common wheat land set to orchard last year were this year assessed at the enhanced figures under the caption of orchard land. A substantial, natural and healthy increase in valuation of all other property is seen by the table of assessments.

That Union county is not given over to the sheep business to any material extent is shown by the fact that there are nearly as many horses and mules in Union county as there are sheep. The number of acres of tillable land, cattle, sheep, swine, horses are enumerated.

Big Items Gone.

It must, too, be remembered that that large corporations of Union county are not included in this table. The state board assesses all corporations and hundreds of thousands of dollars will later be added on to the totals herein so that the figures given are not the actual base on which the tax levy will be based. The assessments fixed by the state will be transferred to the assessor later on.

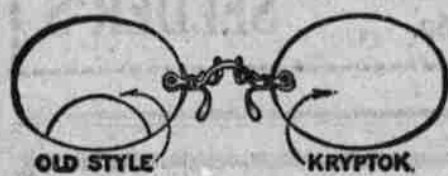

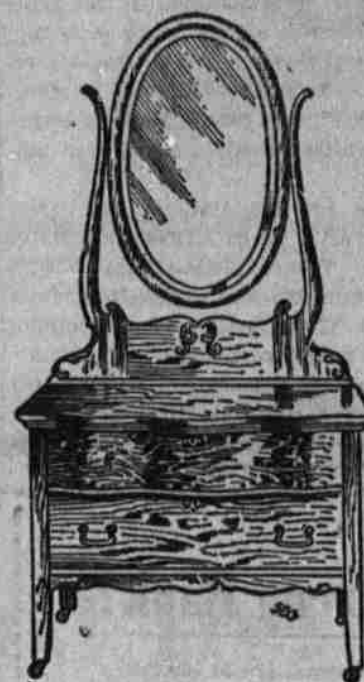
