### EARLY SHIPPING BEST

SENDERS OF CHRISTMAS GIFTS ARE CAUTIONED.

Early Shipments Mean Prompt and Sure Deliveries.

Simple but effective rules covering shipment of express packages are laid down by G. M. Hibberd, American Express agent here, and if followed Christmas gifts will not only reach destinations on time but in good shape. Appended are the rules:

1st. Ship your package early--by the 15th of December if possible. The express company will give you a small label to paste on the package reading "Do not open until Christmas."

2nd. Use wooden boxes for packing, especially for glass and other fragile articles, which should be well protected.

3rd. Write the address in full--state, county, city, street and number--on the box or package, with ink or crayon. Tags are frequently torn off and lost. Also enclose sender's card in box.

4th. Write your own address in full somewhere on the package, following the prefix, "From ....."

5th. If not convenient to ship in wooden boxes, use strong wrapping paper.

6th. If package contains anything of perishable nature, write the word "Perishable" in large plain letters.

If you will observe these suggestions, you will greatly assist in the prompt delivery of your gift in good condition.
