LOCALS FAST IN SPURTS AND SLOW IN SPOTS.

Ten Men Take Part in Handing Defeat to Gritty Imblerites.

Superior in size, ability and experience but not outdone in gameness, the entire first team squad of the local high school last evening got its scoring machine properly adjusted—at times—and rolled up a total of 65 points against the Imbler school youngsters at the high school gymnasium before a small but admiring crowd. Imbler's quintet are youngsters, nothing else, and are not much versed in the intricacies of the big sport, yet, lacking some of these things, Coach Fox's youths went through their parts with grim determination and occasionally electrified the audience with a long shoot. P. Norris, Pratt and Hudson were the stellar players on the visiting team.

Ten different men wore the La Grande colors and these frequent substitutions did much to break up teamwork which for the most part was woefully neglected. During the second half spasms of the real "dope" were displayed at time but throughout the game the local Ajaxes didn't seem able to shoot baskets with any degree of certainty, even after brilliant floor work had carried the ball to the goal. Still 65 points in a short game is not so bad at that and with a little more drilling at shooting baskets both from standing and running positions, the team will be able to meet the best in the country. A half dozen remedial weaknesses were disclosed but with the keen competition prevailing these faults can easily be removed. Woods, Bolton and Reynolds scored the most goals albeit Ralston dropped a couple in the basket from near the middle of the floor and Roberts, Bohnenkamp and Lottes climbed before the calcium with baskets from guard and center positions. Stoddard broke into "fast company" for the first time and Crawley did something for his alma mater by scoring a free throw during the short period of his entry.
