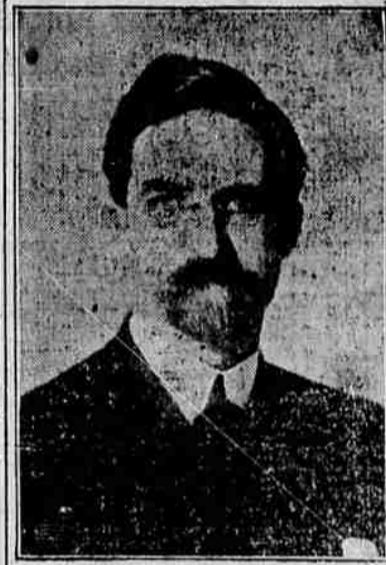
EUGENE WOOD COMING

Will Conduct Lecture in High School Auditorium.
