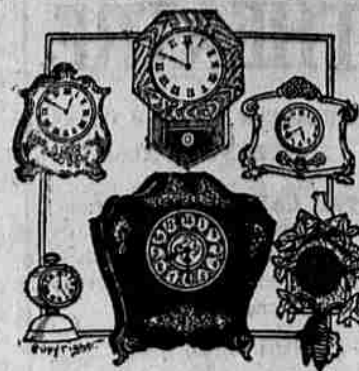

BOYCOTT THE UNION CENTRAL

DRUMMERS WHO PATRONIZE THE "DINKY" MUST SUFFER.

Telephone Topics Also Discussed at Union Meeting Saturday.

That the campaign to frustrate the abandonment of the Union junction station is not ill timed or exploding half cocked cropped out at various intervals last Saturday at Union when plans of procedure were outlined and agreed to. Among the tangible plans

to be followed is a boycott against all drummers who use the "dinky" to reach Union with. Unless he patronizes the automobile buss line to be established in competition to the Union Central passenger train between the station and Union town, he need not look for any orders in that town. The house that persists in sending goods over the line will find no future orders awaiting them.

"The struggle will be long and to the bitter end," agreed a mass meeting of business men Saturday afternoon. All factionalism has been dropped by the wayside and the business men stand a united front. One point expressed specifically is that Union is not in any way opposed to the proposed motor car service between Union and La Grande—they object only to the abandonment of Union junction.

The co-operative telephone was like-

wise given consideration Saturday afternoon. A committee of three consisting of M. S. Levy, Will Wright and A. J. Goodbrod, was appointed to select a man who will solicit subscribers to the telephone now formed at Elgin and which aims to construct across the valley as soon as assurance is given that the Union end of the county will support it. Elgin promoters of the new company were in attendance and they passed through the city last night on their way home feeling that ample backing will be given it at Union. Will Vogel presided at the meeting which jointly considered railroad and telephone affairs.
