## CHUMOS SERIES START ON WED.

HAS ENDORSEMENT OF MANY

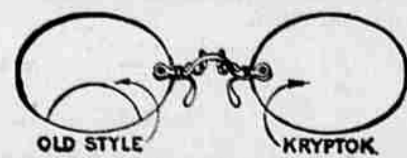
