LEWTAS COMES HERE THURSDAY

ERROR IN ANNOUNCEMENT MADE
YESTERDAY.

Well Known Traveler and Author to
Speak at Auditorium.

John Lewtas of Tacoma, Wash., will give one of his most popular travel lectures on "What I Saw in England, Ireland, Scotland, France and Italy" in the La Grande high school auditorium on Thursday, January 4th at 8 p. m. The lecture will be illustrated by the most up-to-date stereopticon and 200 of the most superb views ever shown in the Pacific northwest. These views were taken specially for this lecture by one of the finest photographers in London, England, who accompanied Mr. Lewtas on his journeys into Europe. Rome, the eternal city, with St. Peter's, the Coliseum, the Mamertine prison, the vatican museum, and will come next a rapid visit to Naples, Florence and Venice will be vividly seen and described and a series of masterpieces of the finest pieces of statuary, and paintings and finishing up with a wonderful description of Milan cathedral will end a two hour lecture which is conceded to be the best ever given in the west. 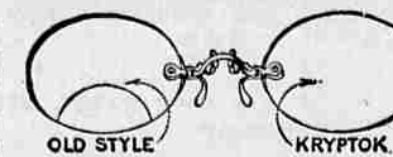
