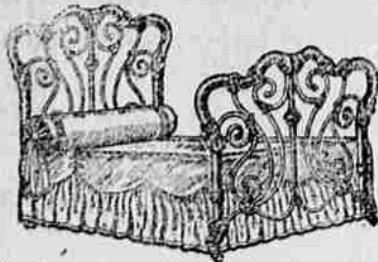

NEARLY FROZEN TO DEATH DRIVING IN FROM BURNS

Illustrating the bitter cold prevailing during the last cold snap in interior Oregon is the following from the Baker Democrat: With both sides of his face frozen and otherwise feeling the effect of his hardships, Dr. George Cleary, of Burns, and two companions reached this city yesterday after an experience which they will never forget, and which nearly claimed the lives of the members of the party who made the attempt to drive across the country from Burns to Prairie City last Sunday.

They left Burns in the forenoon, and made good progress until they were overtaken by the blizzard just before they reached the first stage station in the evening. In spite of the weather they decided to push forward and left late at night with a four horse team. The heavy wind drifted the snow so deeply that they soon lost the road and for hours wandered

around, afraid to stand still as the thermometer was 27 degrees below zero. As near as they can estimate they made eight miles in ten hours. Finally, almost exhausted, the driver stumbled onto a mail box post, and by the surroundings knew where they were.

Facing the storm they pressed on and reached the next station almost exhausted and suffering intensely from the cold.

They succeeded in reaching Prairie City Monday night, with easier traveling on the last end of the journey. Two members of the party with the doctor were contractors working at Burns and one of these men had both feet frozen. Dr. Cleary says that it was the worst experience he ever had and that the storm was the worst in Harney county in many years. He came to Baker to meet his wife and daughter, who are expected home from an eastern trip.

BREWER NEXT SPEAKER ON THE LYCEUM COURSE

As the third number of the socialist lyceum course, George D. Brewer, of Girard, Kansas, will speak on "The War of the Classes," at the high school auditorium on January 15th at 8 p. m.

It may not be understood that as alleged by local members of the party, the socialists are opposed to all forms of violence which occur in connection with labor troubles, holding to the theory that the peaceful rule of a democratic majority is the only safe and stable form of government. No more remarkable example of this has been afforded in recent years than the sudden and sweeping change of position which the socialists made in relation to the McNamara affairs. Almost unanimously they joined with the labor unions in defending the accused men so long as they could be believed innocent of violence, and with equal unanimity the socialists changed front the moment that it was established that the labor leaders had made use of dynamite.

So careful, in fact, are the socialists to exclude from their ranks those who believe in violence that their applications for party membership includes a specific endorsement of the "Principle of Political Action," the theory being that only through votes and majorities

can great changes be safely effected. Local socialists strongly insist that in settling what they call the class war, every form of force not expressed in peaceful strikes and at the ballot
